I. What you need to purchase for this class:

- A. Tote Bag Project (Will need for the second class)
 - 3/4 yard of fabric for your tote bag
 - 1/2 yard of lining fabric
 - · coordinating thread
- B. Zipper Pouch Project (Should have for the third class)
 - 1/4-1/3 yard of pouch fabric
 - 9" zipper
 - · coordinating thread
- C. Individual Project (Will need by class four or five; will discuss ahead of time)
 - Project pattern
 - · Fabric required
 - · Findings and notions required
- **II.** Tools you may want to consider for your sewing kit: You do not need to purchase any of these items for this class. We will review this list in the first class.
