

## Materials list

**Basic Chair for Re-upholstering.** Please send me a picture, [haleh.pedram@gmail.com](mailto:haleh.pedram@gmail.com) so we can be sure that this is a project suitable for our basic upholstery workshop.

**Fabric for your project.** If you are re-upholstering a basic seat, measure across the seat horizontally and vertically to get the measurement, make sure to add about 3 inches in each direction to have the proper amount to pull the material taut. If you have multiple chairs that you would like to purchase fabric for, consider if there is a pattern, how that pattern would be placed, and if it would cause some waste that you would need to consider when deciding how much fabric you need in total.

**VisArts will have all of the tools that you will need, just for your information, here are the Basic Tools**



Staple Puller

Mallet

Diagonal tip pliers (any pliers would work, these are my personal preference, consider grabbing a staple with pliers and consider what kind would feel best for you)

Fabric Scissors

The staple puller that most people learn with looks like this, I prefer the one up top, but can't think of any specific benefits of one over the other.

A tackhammer will come in handy, but is not essential to this workshop
