- Hoop: 6" or 4"

- Embroidery floss: ANY COLORS!

Note: do not purchase "craft thread" (such as Prism), these are low quality threads that will fray!\*

- Needles

Embroidery needles can be sharp or blunt. Both are useful, but you will need to handle sharp needles carefully.

- A small pillow or pincushion to keep your needles in when you are not using them:

- Optional: Fusible web for an iron-on patch
