

Relief Printing at Home with Barry O'Keefe

- Speedball Linocutter with V-gouge, U-gouge attachment
- Speedball waterbased black printing ink
- Speedball ink brayer
- Rubber Block - 4"x6"
- Linoleum Block, mounted - 4"x6"
- Woodblock - 4x6" (Shina or basswood plywood through Mclains)
- Wooden spoon (or metal spoon in a pinch)
- Paper for printing. Recommended: Rice paper or mulberry paper, but any thin white paper may be used. Copy paper or even newsprint.
- Note: All supplies may be purchased at Plaza Art on Grace St, with the exception of woodblocks which must be purchased online.
