

Exploring Abstraction, Plus Experimental Painting

- Pick out a palette of 6 ½-pint paint samples from Lowe's: a white, black, blue, red, yellow, and green. You can pick out any shades of those; it's up to you. Choose whichever colors speak to you! - One Plaza Studio Gesso Pint at <https://www.plazaart.com/plaza-studio-gesso-pint>.
- One pack of watercolor paper. An XL Watercolor Pad 9x12 will do: <https://www.plazaart.com/xl-watercolor-pad-9x12>
- A canvas of your choice from Michaels, Plaza, or Blick. Any size will work, as long as you pick a shape and size that's exciting to you!

Any watercolor pad will do. If you already have sewing thread at home, feel free to bring it, and canvases as well if you happen to own spares of those! But neither of these two extra items are required, just those in the list above.
