Please purchase the following materials before our first class together. These materials are all available at Plaza Art Supply located at 927 W Grace St, Richmond, VA 23220. They know the materials well and can answer any questions you may have.

Materials:

- Soft Pastels: Select from one of these pastel sets. The Nupastel is very good for the beginner and the Sennelier pastel, a much softer pastel, for the more intermediate level student who understands color mixing and hand pressure:
- Nupastel by Prismacolor (hard pastel): 12 color set or 24 color set
- Rembrandt (soft pastel): half length, 15 color set or the 30 color set
- Sennelier (extra soft): a better quality pastel also half length, 20 color set or the 40 color set
- Oil Pastels: Select from one of these Pentel Oil Pastel Sets
 - 16 color set
 - 25 color set
 - 36 color set
- Pastel Papers: Select from this list (5) 8.5" x 11" and (3) 19" x 25" sheets of pastel paper. The student may also purchase pads of these pastel papers in the same size if they wish.
- Canson (Mi-Teintes) sizes 19" x 25"
- Mixed Media Paper – you may want to try a sheet of Colourfix Sanded Pastel paper size 20" x 26" which you can cut into four sheets.
- Graphite Pencil (2B)
- Soft Vine Charcoal (Windsor & Newton preferred) 3-stick set
- Kryton Workable Fixatif Spray
- Sketch Book – any kind

Optional:

If you'd like to use the mixed media paper, consider getting these two items –

- Weber Odorless Turpenoid (16 oz)
- Filber paint brush (no. 8)
