### *Suggested Materials List*

Sketchbook (spiral bound recommended)

Charcoal pencil

Tear away disposable paper palette

Old cookie tray or butcher tray to use as base for sheets in paper palette

Small containers with lids, such as yogurt or baby food jars for saving mixed paints

Large plastic container for holding water and cleaning brushes

Masking tape or blue painters tape

Several sponge brushes

Synthetic brushes: These can be purchased in a set or individually

Old bath towels or rags

Palette knife, a plastic spray bottle with a fine mist (recycled is great)

Organizer for art materials

A bar of ivory soap for cleaning brushes

Pre-stretched canvas - recommended size, approx 24x18 inches

Acrylic gloss or matte transparent medium

Starter list of acrylic paint or individual containers of the following colors:

o white

o cadmium yellow

o yellow ochre

o ultramarine

o blue

o cadmium red

o alizarin crimson

o cerulean blue

o viridian green

o burnt umber

o black

\* (Liquitex or Golden brand paints are terrific but feel free to purchase whatever is on sale)

Optional:

o A rolling travel or craft cart can save you many trips to the car

o Paper towels

o 24 inch ruler
