# • Scrap of rough fabric like canvas or denim

o 5 x 7 inches ish is enough

# • Roll of blue painter's tape in 1/2 inch or larger

- **Newsprint** or scrap paper that is the same size or bigger than your sketchbook

  - We won't use more than 12-15 sheets of paper

# • Sketchbook in size 11 x 14 inches or larger

- Ideally heavyweight drawing paper
- I suggest getting a pad with fewer sheets of thicker paper over a pad of many sheets of thinner paper
- I prefer and will use a size a bit bigger: 18 x 24 inches, but please choose the paper size that works best for you, though I don't recommend going smaller than 11 x 14 inches
- We won't use more than 12-15 sheets of paper

- Something to keep all your supplies protected like a hard pencil case
  - Charcoal can be messy and fragile

#### **OPTIONAL:**

- Disposable gloves
  - if you think you might not like the texture of charcoal on your hands (charcoal is not toxic but some people don't like the powdery feel of it)
- Photos you'd like to draw from
- Physical objects you'd like to draw
- Paint brush you don't mind getting dirty with charcoal
  - Anything from a ¼ inch to 1 inch in size
