- **Vine or willow charcoal in “soft”**

- **White Vinyl eraser**

- **Blending stumps**

- Regular **sandpaper** in 80 or 100 grit, OR sandpaper pad

- **Scrap of rough fabric like canvas or denim**
  - 5 x 7 inches ish is enough

### OPTIONAL:

- **Small Mechanical eraser**
  - Good for tiny details

- **Disposable gloves**
  - if you think you might not like the texture of charcoal on your hands  
(charcoal is not toxic but some people don't like the powdery feel of it)
- **Photos of people you'd like to draw from**
- **Paint brush you don't mind getting dirty with charcoal**
  - Anything from a ¼ inch to 1 inch in size
