Supply List:

1. [Watercolor Cards](#)
2. [Canson Watercolor paper](#) (1 pad, about 9 x 12")
3. Watercolor brushes (these sizes will help you have a variety: [1" flat brush](#), variety of [round brushes](#))
4. Watercolor paint palette- There are a lot of different types out there. I will be using [Windsor & Newton](#) which is top quality but I also enjoy the [bright colors](#) so you can supplement with another set.
5. Mixing palette (watercolors mix really well on a [porcelain palette](#), or a [plastic mixing palette](#) will work, or a plastic lid from your recycling) There are lots of different sizes and shapes- pick what you like!
6. 2 cups for water (Any old cups will do). I use [these](#) silicone, collapsible cups, great for travel.
7. 1 roll Painters tape (I prefer the green [Frog tape](#))
8. Paper towels (or old rag)
9. Micron pens in variety of sizes 005, [02](#), 08
10. Pencil/ eraser
