Materials List

- Sketchbook (spiral bound recommended)
- Charcoal pencil
- Tear away disposable paper palette
- Old cookie tray or butcher tray to use as base for sheets in paper palette
- Small containers with lids, such as yogurt cups or baby food jars for saving mixed paint
- Large plastic container for holding water and cleaning brushes
- Masking tape or blue painters tape
- Several sponge brushes
- Synthetic brushes: These can be purchased in a set or individually
- Old bath towels or rags
- Palette knife, a plastic spray bottle with a fine mist (recycled is great)
- Tackle box or basket or carry bag for art materials
- A bar of ivory soap for cleaning brushes
- Pre-stretched canvas recommended size, approx 24x18 inches
- Acrylic gloss or matte transparent medium
- Starter list of acrylic paint or individual containers of the following colors:
 - o white
 - o cadmium yellow
 - yellow ochre
 - o ultramarine
 - o blue
 - o cadmium red
 - alizarin crimson
 - o cerulean blue
 - viridian green
 - burnt umber
 - o black
 - * (Liquitex or Golden brand paints recommended)

Optional:

- o A rolling travel or craft cart can save you many trips to the car
- Paper towels
- o 24 inch ruler
