To bring to the first class:

- 1 sketchbook (approx. 8" x 10", spiral bound)
- Derwent Brand pencils: 2H, H, HB, 2B, 4B
- 1 plastic template for circles
- 1 kneaded eraser
- Drawing board—approximately 18" x 24"
- Tuff Stuff (white) eraser
- Fractis (white) eraser
- Handheld pencil sharpener
- Roll of White artist's tape

For class #2 and beyond:

- 1 pad of pastel paper, assorted colors (should include a few grays)
- 1 set of Generals Charcoal pencils
- 1 White Charcoal pencil
- 1 set of NuPastels (semi-hard)
- 1 chamois cloth
- 1 small sandpaper board for sharpening charcoal
- 1 package of stumps
- White artist's tape
- A large bag/tote to carry all this stuff in
- 2 large sheets of Rives BFK (flat, do not roll)
- Cardboard portfolio to carry Rives paper
